This picture shows the cooler in operation in the cellar of one of the Cotswold Food Clubs pubs, The Old Fleece Inn at Woodchester.


They were so impressed with the installation and potential savings they decided to have another installed in The Old Lodge, Minchinhampton.

ARE YOU LEGAL?

Complying with Regulations for F Gas in Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Systems

You may not be aware but in line with the European Union F-Gas Regulation of 2014 it is a legal requirement for all businesses which install, maintain or service stationary refrigeration, air-conditioning, heat-pump (RAC) equipment that contains "F gas" (fluorinated greenhouse gases) refrigerants to hold a Company Certificate issued by an appointed Company Certification Body.

I am pleased to say that TKR are registered with REFCOM who have been formally named by Defra.



In addition, the F-Gas Regulation requires companies and other organisations with air conditioning plant to ensure that the fluorinated greenhouse gases are contained within the systems.

Labelling

Equipment must be labelled with the following information

- Type of refrigerant
- Amount of refrigerant
- CO2 Equivalent in tonnes
- Global Warming Potential (GWP) of the refrigerant

Leaks

If a leak is found during a check it must be repaired and the check repeated within one month to ensure the repair has worked.

Records

The owner of the equipment must keep records of all refrigeration equipment that is on the premises.

These details need to be included:

- Quantity and type of refrigerant in system when installed
- Quantity and type of refrigerant added during any maintenance or service repairs (eg leak repairs)
- Dates and results of all mandatory leak checks
- Refrigerant that has been recycled or reclaimed
- Quantity of any refrigerant recovered

These records must be kept for 5 years and made available to Government officials if requested. If you can't prove you have adhered to this Government Legislation your insurance cover may be invalidated.
